



Administering your domain

If, you select the domain you have just added. You will be taken to a new screen where you can setup your FTP account, access your file manager, and set advanced options.

Adding an FTP account

1. Click "add new".
2. Now specify the username/password and folder this account has access to. "/" is the root. Files stored here are not accessible via the web. The WWWROOT folder is the root of your web site.

If you need multiple FTP accounts, let us know, they are available as an add-on.

Adding a DSN

Your database must first be uploaded first into the /db folder

1. go to the DOMAINS menu and select your domain, and click the ADVANCED SETTINGS icon.
2. Now click ODBC DSN's
3. Click ADD NEW
4. Microsoft Access should be checked. This is the only type of database you can choose unless you have purchased an SQL Server database.
5. Click next.
6. Now give a name for your DSN and select your database file.

NOTE: Because of the way CFMX handles DSN's Wisconsin Web Host needs to manually enable your DSN in the ColdFusion Administrator after you have created it. SO please contact support with your account name and DSN after you have set it up.

Quotas

On the left panel of HELM you can see your resource usage, click MORE for further info. If you exceed your quotas, you will need to purchase additional resources from the ADDONS section, so keep an eye on it. Accounts exceeding their limits without buying extra resources will be suspended until payment is made.

If you wish to host multiple sites, you can do this from your account simply by adding a new hosting package and setting it up as above.
